CHAPTER 2000-473

House Bill No. 1769

An act relating to the City of Hollywood, Broward County; amending chapter 30836, Laws of Florida, 1955, as amended, relating to the Employees' Retirement Fund and the Firefighters' Pension Fund, respectively, to provide for amendments to Articles X and XII upon approval by a "majority plus one" vote of the City Commission and 50 percent plus one of the voting members of the respective fund; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 10.07 is added to chapter 30836, Laws of Florida, 1955, as amended, to read:

Section 10.07. This article, including this section, may be amended, in whole or in part, or repealed by the City Commission upon approval of any such amendment or repeal by:

(a) A "majority plus one" vote of the City Commission and 50 percent plus one of the voting members of the Employees' Retirement Fund; or

(b) A majority vote of those qualified electors of the city voting in a referendum election called for such purpose by the City Commission and held in accordance with the provisions of law relating to elections currently in force in the City, or held in conjunction with a primary, general, or other special election held in the City.

Section 2. Section 12.23 is added to chapter 30836, Laws of Florida, 1955, as amended, to read:

Section 12.23. This article, including this section, may be amended, in whole or in part, or repealed by the City Commission upon approval of any such amendment or repeal by:

(a) A "majority plus one" vote of the City Commission and 50 percent plus one of the voting members of the Firefighters' Pension Fund; or

(b) A majority vote of those qualified electors of the city voting in a referendum election called for such purpose by the City Commission and held in accordance with the provisions of law relating to elections currently in force in the City, or held in conjunction with a primary, general, or other special election held in the City.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
