

House Bill No. 387

An act relating to a public records exemption for certain information obtained by the direct-support organization authorized to assist in the promotion of sports-related industries; amending s. 288.12295, F.S., which provides an exemption from public records requirements for the identity of donors and prospective donors to the direct-support organization; reenacting such exemption and removing the October 2, 2001, repeal thereof scheduled under the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the October 2, 2001, repeal of said section scheduled pursuant to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995, section 288.12295, Florida Statutes, is reenacted and amended to read:

288.12295 Promotion and development of sports-related industries; direct-support organization; confidentiality of donor identities.—The identity of a donor or prospective donor to the direct-support organization authorized under s. 288.1229 who desires to remain anonymous and all information identifying such donor or prospective donor are confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. Such anonymity shall be maintained in audit reports. ~~This section expires October 2, 2001, and is subject to review by the Legislature under the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15 before that date.~~

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001.
