

House Bill No. 965

An act relating to Broward County, Florida; providing for deannexation of certain lands from the Town of Davie; providing for annexation of certain lands into the Town of Southwest Ranches; providing for confirmation of corporate existence of the Town of Southwest Ranches on June 6, 2000; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The lands contained in the following legal description are hereby deannexed from the Town of Davie, Florida:

Tract 'A; of "SOUTH BROWARD DRAINAGE DISTRICT" according to the plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 144, Page 12 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.

Said Lands situate, lying and being in the Town of Davie, Broward County, Florida, and containing 580.591 square feet (13.331 acres) more or less.

Section 2. The present corporate limits of the Town of Southwest Ranches, Broward County, are hereby extended and enlarged so as to include, in addition to the territory presently within its corporate limits, the following:

Tract 'A; of "SOUTH BROWARD DRAINAGE DISTRICT" according to the plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 144, Page 12 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.

Said Lands situate, lying and being in the Town of Davie, Broward County, Florida, and containing 580.591 square feet (13.331 acres) more or less.

Section 3. Notwithstanding any provision of chapter 2000-475, Laws of Florida, or any other prior enacted law to the contrary, the municipal existence of the Town of Southwest Ranches shall be recognized as of June 6, 2000.

Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
