

Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 622

An act relating to commercial transportation; providing a penalty for the illegal use of any means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance to commit any felony or to facilitate the commission of any felony; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Commercial transportation; penalty for use in commission of a felony.—

(1) It is unlawful for any person to attempt to obtain, solicit to obtain, or obtain any means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance, including vessels, aircraft, railroad trains, or commercial vehicles as defined in section 316.003(66), Florida Statutes, with the intent to use such public or commercial transportation or conveyance to commit any felony or to facilitate the commission of any felony.

(2) Any person who violates the provisions of subsection (1) commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided for in section 775.082, section 775.083, or section 775.084, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
