## CHAPTER 2003-285

## House Bill No. 773

An act relating to the Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority; amending s. 343.63, F.S.; revising membership of the governing board of the authority; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (2) and (3) of section 343.63, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

343.63 Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority.—

- (2) The governing board of the authority shall consist of <u>five</u> 11 voting members, and 1 nonvoting member as follows:
- (a) The <u>chairs of the</u> county commissions of Seminole, Orange, and Osceola Counties, or another member of the commission designated by the county chair, shall each <u>serve as a elect a commissioner as that commission</u>'s representative on the board. The commissioner must be a member of the county commission when elected and for the full extent of his or her term. The terms of the county commissioners on the governing board of the authority shall be 2 years.
- (b) The <u>mayor mayors</u> of the <u>city cities</u> of <u>Altamonte Springs</u>, Orlando, <u>or a member of the Orlando City Council designated by the and Kissimmee</u>, <u>or a member of each city commission designated by each mayor</u>, shall serve <u>as a representative</u> a <u>term of 2 years</u> on the board <u>for the full extent of his</u> or her term.
- (c) The Governor shall appoint five members to the board. Two of the members shall be residents of Orange County, one member shall be a resident of Seminole County, one member shall be a resident of Osceola County, and one member shall be a resident of the City of Orlando. All five members shall serve a term of 4 years.
- $\underline{(c)(d)}$  The Secretary of Transportation shall appoint the district secretary, or his or her designee, for the district within which the area served by the authority is located and this member shall be a <u>voting nonvoting</u> member.
- (3) A vacancy during a term shall be filled by the respective appointing authority in the same manner as the original appointment and only for the balance of the unexpired term.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
