CHAPTER 2003-352

House Bill No. 833

An act relating to Levy County; amending ch. 98-473, Laws of Florida, relating to the Cedar Key Water and Sewer District; repealing a provision relating to bids for contracts; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 10 of chapter 98-473, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 10. <u>Reserved.</u> (a) All work done by the District in the construction, reconstruction, improvement, or enlargement of the water supply and distribution system or sewage system involving the expenditures of more than \$1,000, except for the purchase of the chemicals and supplies for water and sewage treatment for which the consideration involved does not exceed \$1,500, shall be done by contract entered into following advertisement for bids received on a stated date pursuant to notice for sealed bids published at least once each week for 2 consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation among contractors in the state. All such contracts shall be secured by a performance bond in an amount not less than 80 percent of the contract price, furnished by a surety company or companies authorized to do business in the state.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
