CHAPTER 2004-31

House Bill No. 457

An act relating to the Lowry Park Zoo; recognizing the Lowry Park Zoo as a state center for Florida species conservation and biodiversity; providing for construction; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>The Lowry Park Zoo, a not-for-profit corporation located in the</u> <u>City of Tampa, is hereby recognized as a state center for Florida species</u> <u>conservation and biodiversity, including captive breeding, animal hus-</u> <u>bandry, conservation education, veterinary care and rescue, rehabilitation,</u> <u>research, and release of Florida's endangered and threatened wildlife spe-</u> <u>cies, including, but not limited to, the Florida manatee, Florida panther, red</u> <u>wolf, Key deer, Key Largo wood rat, and whooping crane. Such recognition</u> <u>shall not be construed as exempting the Lowry Park Zoo from the regulatory</u> <u>purview of the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission.</u>

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
