

Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 2196

An act relating to trust funds; creating s. 985.4043, F.S.; creating the Shared County/State Juvenile Detention Trust Fund within the Department of Juvenile Justice; providing for sources of funds and purposes; providing for future review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 985.4043, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

985.4043 Shared County/State Juvenile Detention Trust Fund.—

(1) The Shared County/State Juvenile Detention Trust Fund is created within the Department of Juvenile Justice.

(2) The fund is established for use as a depository for funds to be used for the costs of predisposition juvenile detention. Moneys credited to the trust fund shall consist of funds from the counties' share of the costs for predisposition juvenile detention.

(3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State Constitution, the Shared County/State Juvenile Detention Trust Fund shall, unless terminated sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2009. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
