CHAPTER 2005-90

House Bill No. 1765

An act relating to the Federal Grants Trust Fund; creating s. 947.045, F.S.; creating the Federal Grants Trust Fund within the Florida Parole Commission; providing for the source and use of funds; providing for annual carryover of funds; providing for review and termination or re-creation of the trust fund; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 947.045, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

<u>947.045</u> Federal Grants Trust Fund.—The Federal Grants Trust Fund is hereby created, to be administered by the Florida Parole Commission.

(1) Funds to be credited to the trust fund shall consist of receipts from federal grants and shall be used for the various purposes for which the federal funds were intended.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the trust fund at the end of the year and shall be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund.

(3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2) of Art. III of the State Constitution, the Federal Grants Trust Fund shall be terminated on July 1, 2009, unless terminated sooner. Before its scheduled termination, the trust fund shall be reviewed as provided in s. 215.3206(1) and (2).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
