

Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 2432

An act relating to prepaid limited and discount medical plans; amending s. 636.044, F.S.; exempting certain sellers of travel from licensing requirements to sell prepaid limited health service contracts that cover the cost of transportation provided by an air ambulance service; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the “John F. Cosgrove Act.”

Section 2. Subsection (5) is added to section 636.044, Florida Statutes, to read:

636.044 Agent licensing.—

(5) A person registered as a seller of travel under s. 559.928 is not required to be licensed under this section in order to sell prepaid limited health service contracts that cover the cost of transportation provided by an air ambulance service licensed pursuant to s. 401.251. The prepaid limited health service contract for such coverage is, however, subject to all applicable provisions of this chapter.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
