

House Bill No. 1129

An act relating to the Florida State Employees' Charitable Campaign; amending s. 110.181, F.S.; revising the manner in which certain undesignated funds are distributed to participating charities; distributing the funds proportionately to such charities based upon their percentage of designations in each fiscal agent area; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 110.181, Florida Statutes, is amended, and paragraph (e) is added to that subsection, to read:

110.181 Florida State Employees' Charitable Campaign.—

(2) SELECTION OF FISCAL AGENTS; COST.—

(d) A local steering committee shall be established in each fiscal agent area to assist in conducting the campaign and to direct the distribution of undesignated funds remaining after partial distribution pursuant to s. 110.181(2)(e). The committee shall be composed of state employees selected by the fiscal agent from among recommendations provided by interested participating organizations, if any, and approved by the Statewide Steering Committee.

(e) Participating charitable organizations that provide direct services in a local fiscal agent's area shall receive the same percentage of undesignated funds as the percentage of designated funds they receive. The undesignated funds remaining following allocation to these charitable organizations shall be distributed by the local steering committee.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
