## CHAPTER 2006-325

## House Bill No. 927

An act relating to the mosquito control district of Pinellas County; repealing chapter 18792, Laws of Florida, 1937, and chapter 67-1920, Laws of Florida; abolishing the mosquito control district of Pinellas County; transferring all assets and liabilities of the district to the county; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Special laws relating to the mosquito control district of Pinellas County, including chapter 18792, Laws of Florida, 1937, and chapter 67-1920, Laws of Florida, are repealed and shall become ordinances of Pinellas County as provided in section 5.02(a) of the Pinellas County Charter.</u>

Section 2. <u>The mosquito control district of Pinellas County is abolished.</u> <u>All assets and liabilities of the district are transferred to Pinellas County,</u> <u>and Pinellas County shall assume all the district's obligations.</u>

Section 3. This act shall take effect January 1, 2007.
