

House Bill No. 1631

An act relating to the Village of North Palm Beach, Palm Beach County; designating a portion of State Road A1A within the village as Jack Nicklaus Drive; authorizing and directing the village to change street signs and markers, mailing addresses, and 911 emergency telephone system listings and to erect signs and markers accordingly; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Jack Nicklaus Drive designated; signs, mailing addresses, listings, and markers.—

(1) Notwithstanding ss. 267.062 and 334.071, Florida Statutes, that portion of State Road A1A (U.S. 1) beginning at its intersection with PGA Boulevard and ending just west of the Burnt Bridge, Florida Department of Transportation bridge number 930361, in Palm Beach County is designated as “Jack Nicklaus Drive.”

(2) The Village of North Palm Beach within which the new Jack Nicklaus Drive is located is authorized and directed to change street signs and markers, mailing addresses, and 911 emergency telephone number system listings to reflect the designation.

(3) The Village of North Palm Beach is authorized and directed to erect the appropriate signs and markers upon Jack Nicklaus Drive as described in subsection (1).

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
