## CHAPTER 2007-128

## Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 1376

An act relating to the Department of the Lottery; amending s. 24.105, F.S.; authorizing the department to hold patents; requiring that the department notify the Department of State when the Department of the Lottery secures property rights by patent, copyright, or trademark; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (10) of section 24.105, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

24.105 Powers and duties of department.—The department shall:

(10) <u>Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 286</u>, have the authority to hold <u>patents</u>, copyrights, trademarks, and service marks and enforce its rights with respect thereto. <u>The department shall notify the Department of State in writing whenever property rights by patent, copyright, or trademark are secured by the department.</u>

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
