CHAPTER 2007-201

House Bill No. 7127

An act relating to a review under the Open Government Sunset Review Act regarding the Public Employee Optional Retirement Program; amending s. 121.4501, F.S., which provides an exemption from public records requirements for personal identifying information of a participant in the Public Employee Optional Retirement Program contained in Florida Retirement System records held by the State Board of Administration or the Department of Management Services; making editorial changes; removing superfluous provisions; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (19) of section 121.4501, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

121.4501 Public Employee Optional Retirement Program.—

(19) PARTICIPANT RECORDS.—All Personal identifying information <u>of</u> regarding a participant in the Public Employee Optional Retirement Program contained in Florida Retirement System records held by the State Board of Administration or the Department of Management Services, or their agents, employees, or contractors is exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. The department or board may use such exempt information as necessary in any legal or administrative proceeding. This subsection is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed October 2, 2007, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
