

Council Substitute for House Bill No. 1603

An act relating to the City of Pensacola; repealing s. 94 of chapter 15425 (1931) and chapters 18779 (1937), 24802 (1947), 24806 (1947), 26462 (1949), 31159 (1955), 57-1717, 57-1721, 71-845, 73-590, and 73-592, Laws of Florida, to abolish obsolete city charter and related special act provisions relating to the acceptance of gifts, extraterritorial industrial plant projects, work periods for firefighters and police officers, transportation for hire, gas and petroleum tax, honorary mayor, annexed districts, transportation regulation, and employee group insurance; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 94 of chapter 15425, Laws of Florida, 1931; chapter 18779, Laws of Florida, 1937; chapter 24802, Laws of Florida, 1947; chapter 24806, Laws of Florida, 1947; chapter 26462, Laws of Florida, 1949; chapter 31159, Laws of Florida, 1955; and chapters 57-1717, 57-1721, 71-845, 73-590, and 73-592, Laws of Florida, are repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
