

House Bill No. 1609

An act relating to the City of Lauderdale Lakes, Broward County; amending section 3.13 of the Charter of the City of Lauderdale Lakes, to permit persons who are not city residents to serve on city boards and committees; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 3.13 of the Charter of the City of Lauderdale Lakes is amended to read:

Section 3.13. Boards, authorities and commissions. In addition to the regular committees established under Section 4.01(1) [sic], the city commission may create by ordinance boards, authorities and commissions and may specify the membership and duties thereof. ~~All persons serving on boards, authorities and commissions shall be residents or employee of Lauderdale Lakes and shall take an oath of office as provided in section 3.05.~~ No person shall serve on more than two (2) such boards, authorities, or commissions, and members of such boards shall serve without compensation but may receive necessary expenses if approved by the city commission. Such boards, authorities and commissioners shall be part of the municipal government and shall, whenever practicable, utilize the services available through the regular departments, offices and agencies of the city, including the legal officer, as authorized by the city commission.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
