CHAPTER 2010-119

Senate Bill No. 502

An act relating to special investigators; amending s. 27.251, F.S.; deleting a requirement that investigators be employed on a full-time basis; specifying matters that may be investigated by special investigators; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 27.251, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

27.251 Special organized crime investigators.—The state attorney of each judicial circuit is authorized to employ any municipal or county police officer or sheriff's deputy on a full-time basis as an investigator for the state attorney's office with full powers of arrest throughout the judicial circuit provided such investigator serves on a special task force to investigate matters involving criminal activity the detection of which might benefit from a special task force organized crime, and, provided further, that the salary of such municipal or county police officer or sheriff's deputy shall be paid by the city, county, or sheriff by which the investigator is principally employed, and with the consent of the county, sheriff, or municipality. The arrest powers granted in this section may herein shall be exercised only in the furtherance of the conduct of the business of the special task force to which such municipal or county police officer or sheriff's deputy is assigned by the said state attorney.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
