CHAPTER 2010-213

Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 2742

An act relating to a nonbinding statewide advisory referendum; requiring that a question regarding a balanced federal budget be printed on the ballot and submitted to the voters in the 2010 general election; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. <u>Nonbinding statewide advisory referendum.—At the 2010</u> general election, the following question shall be printed on the ballot and <u>submitted to the voters:</u>

BALANCING THE FEDERAL BUDGET A NONBINDING REFERENDUM CALLING FOR AN AMENDMENT TO THE UNITED STATES CONSTITUTION

In order to stop the uncontrolled growth of our national debt and prevent excessive borrowing by the Federal Government, which threatens our economy and national security, should the United States Constitution be amended to require a balanced federal budget without raising taxes?
