Council Substitute for Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 29

An act relating to road and bridge designations; designating Ray Charles Memorial Parkway in Madison County; designating Deputy Victor J. “Skip” McDonald Memorial Highway and Trooper Charles Eugene Campbell Memorial Highway in Taylor County; designating Frank Pasquarella Way, Bob Arbetter’s Way, and Don Shula Drive in Miami-Dade County; designating Captain Chad Allen Reed, Sr., Memorial Highway in Dixie County; designating Trooper Ronald Gordon Smith Memorial Bridge in Citrus County; directing the Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Ray Charles Memorial Parkway designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of U.S. Highway 90 within the boundaries of the Town of Greenville in Madison County is designated as “Ray Charles Memorial Parkway.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Ray Charles Memorial Parkway as described in subsection (1).

Section 2. Deputy Victor J. “Skip” McDonald Memorial Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of State Road 51 between U.S. Highway 19 at Tennille and the Dixie County line in Taylor County is designated as “Deputy Victor J. ‘Skip’ McDonald Memorial Highway.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Deputy Victor J. “Skip” McDonald Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).

Section 3. Trooper Charles Eugene Campbell Memorial Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of U.S. Highway 19 between Slaughter Road and Harrison Blue Road in Taylor County is designated as “Trooper Charles Eugene Campbell Memorial Highway.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Trooper Charles Eugene Campbell Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).

Section 4. Frank Pasquarella Way designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of Bird Road, S.W. 40th Street, between S.W. 89th Avenue and S.W. 92nd Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as “Frank Pasquarella Way.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Frank Pasquarella Way as described in subsection (1).

Section 5. Bob Arbetter’s Way designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of Bird Road, S.W. 40th Street, between S.W. 87th Avenue and S.W. 89th Avenue in Miami-Dade County is designated as “Bob Arbetter’s Way.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Bob Arbetter’s Way as described in subsection (1).

Section 6. Don Shula Drive designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of Florida’s Turnpike between the interchange at N.W. 199th Street/Dolphin Player Stadium and Dan Marino Boulevard in Miami-Dade County is designated as “Don Shula Drive.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Don Shula Drive as described in subsection (1).

Section 7. Captain Chad Allen Reed, Sr., Memorial Highway designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) That portion of U.S. Highway 19/27A/98, State Road 55, between N.E. 170th Street and the Taylor County line in Dixie County is designated as “Captain Chad Allen Reed, Sr., Memorial Highway.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Captain Chad Allen Reed, Sr., Memorial Highway as described in subsection (1).

Section 8. Trooper Ronald Gordon Smith Memorial Bridge designated; Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers.—

(1) The bridge on U.S. Highway 19/98 in Citrus County at the Cross Florida Barge Canal is designated as “Trooper Ronald Gordon Smith Memorial Bridge.”

(2) The Department of Transportation is directed to erect suitable markers designating Trooper Ronald Gordon Smith Memorial Bridge as described in subsection (1).

Section 9. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010.
