## CHAPTER 2010-265

## House Bill No. 1485

An act relating to Hillsborough County; amending chapter 2001-299, Laws of Florida, relating to the Public Transportation Commission; revising definitions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (1) and (34) of section 3 of chapter 2001-299, Laws of Florida, are amended to read:

Section 3. Definitions.—As used in this act:

(1) "Basic life support ambulance" means any privately or publicly owned vehicle, except those operated by any municipality, that is designed, constructed, reconstructed, maintained, equipped, or operated for and is used for or intended to be used for transportation of <u>a</u> sick or injured <u>person</u> <u>persons</u> requiring or likely to require medical attention during transport by <u>a</u> qualified <u>person</u> persons through the use of techniques such as patient assessment, cardiopulmonary resuscitation, splinting, obstetrical assistance, bandaging, administration of oxygen, application of medical anti-shock trousers, administration of a subcutaneous injection using a premeasured autoinjector of epinephrine to a person suffering an <u>anaphylactic analyphylactic</u> reaction, and other techniques described in the Emergency Medical Technician Basic Training Course Curriculum of the United States Department of Transportation or the Florida Department of Health and the requirements of chapter 401, Florida Statutes.

(34) "Wrecker" means any <u>truck or other privately owned motor driven</u> vehicle <u>that is used to tow, carry, or otherwise transport motor vehicles or</u> vessels upon the streets and highways of this state and that is equipped for that purpose with a boom, winch, car carrier, or other similar equipment and <u>is</u> in the recovery, towing, or removal of wrecked, disabled, stolen, and abandoned motor vehicles and contracted for use by, through, or for any unit of local, county, or state government, and not authorized to transport passengers for hire <u>or any person regularly engaged in towing or storing vehicles</u> or vessels in Hillsborough County pursuant to section 715.07, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
