CHAPTER 2013-129

Senate Bill No. 558

An act relating to letters of credit issued by a Federal Home Loan Bank; amending s. 280.13, F.S.; revising circumstances under which letters of credit issued by a Federal Home Loan Bank are eligible as collateral; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (5) of section 280.13, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

280.13 Eligible collateral.—

- (5) Letters of credit issued by a Federal Home Loan Bank are eligible as collateral under this section provided that:
- (c) Obligations issued by the Federal Home Loan Bank remain <u>triple-A</u> triple A rated by a nationally recognized source <u>or</u>, <u>if no longer triple-A rated</u>, <u>rated by a nationally recognized source at not lower than its rating of the long-term sovereign credit of the United States.</u>

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013.
