

CHAPTER 2015-138

House Bill No. 225

An act relating to flags; providing a short title; creating s. 256.041, F.S.; requiring a United States flag or a state flag that is purchased on or after a specified date by the state, a county, or a municipality for public use to be made in the United States; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. This act may be cited as the “All-American Flag Act.”

Section 2. Section 256.041, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

256.041 Purchase of United States flag or state flag for public use.—
When the state, a county, or a municipality purchases a United States flag or a state flag for public use, the flag must be made in the United States from articles, materials, or supplies, all of which are grown, produced, and manufactured in the United States. This section applies to the purchase of a flag on or after January 1, 2016.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
