## **CHAPTER 98-112**

## Senate Bill No. 1058

An act relating to solid waste management; amending s. 403.7045, F.S.; authorizing the Department of Environmental Protection to allow recycling and reuse of ash residue which meets department standards adopted by rule; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 403.7045, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

403.7045 Application of act and integration with other acts.—

(5) Ash <u>residue</u> generated by a solid waste management facility from the burning of solid waste <u>must</u> shall be disposed of in a properly designed solid waste disposal area that complies with standards developed by the department for the disposal of such ash <u>residue</u>. Rulemaking shall be initiated and at least one public hearing held by February 1, 1989. The department shall work with solid waste management facilities <u>that</u> which burn solid waste to identify and develop methods for recycling and reuse of <u>incinerator</u> ash <u>residue</u> or treated ash <u>residue</u>, and the department may allow such <u>recycling</u> or reuse by an applicant who demonstrates that no significant threat to public health will result and that applicable department standards and <u>criteria</u> will not be violated. The Division of Waste Management shall direct the district offices and bureaus on matters relating to the interpretation and applicability of this subsection. The department may adopt rules necessary for administering this subsection, but the department is not required to amend its existing rules.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
