

CHAPTER 98-194

Senate Bill No. 898

An act relating to postconviction proceedings in capital cases; repealing Rule 3.852, Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, relating to the production of records in postconviction proceedings in capital cases; providing a contingent effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Rule 3.852, Florida Rules of Criminal Procedure, is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 1998, but it shall take effect only if enacted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the membership of each house of the Legislature.

Became a law without the Governor's approval May 24, 1998.
