CHAPTER 2001-23

Senate Bill No. 594

An act relating to the re-creation of the Florida Preservation 2000 Trust Fund without modification; terminating and re-creating the trust fund; carrying forward current balances and continuing current sources and uses thereof; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, the Legislature wishes to extend the life of the Florida Preservation 2000 Trust Fund, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has reviewed the trust fund and has found that it continues to meet an important public purpose, and

WHEREAS, the Legislature has found that existing public policy concerning the trust fund sets adequate parameters for its use, NOW, THERE-FORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Florida Preservation 2000 Trust Fund within the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, FLAIR Number 77-2-332, is terminated and re-created.

(2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund are continued.

Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 2004.
