CHAPTER 2001-321

House Bill No. 911

An act relating to the City of Tampa, Hillsborough County; amending chapter 23559, Laws of Florida, 1945, as amended; revising certain death benefits; repealing all laws in conflict herewith; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subparagraph a. of paragraph 1. of subsection (A) of section 12 of chapter 23559, Laws of Florida, 1945, as amended, is amended to read:

Section 12. Death Benefits.

(A) Division A Employees:

1. Should any retired Employee or active Employee, regardless of age, having earned Pension Credit and participated in this Fund, die and leave a widow or widower, and/or a child or children under the age of 18 years, or one or both solely dependent parents, then the Trustees shall authorize and direct payment of a pension to the widow or widower, and/or child or children, or the parent or parents, but only in the following amounts and on the following conditions:

a. To the widow or widower until she or he dies or remarries, a monthly pension equal to 75 percent of the Employee's Accrued Pension; <u>however</u>, <u>such monthly pension shall be reduced to 50 percent of the Employee's Accrued Pension if such widow or widower remarries</u>.

Section 2. <u>All laws or parts of laws in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.</u>

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
