## CHAPTER 2003-388

## House Bill No. 1731

An act relating to the Florida Keys Mosquito Control District, Monroe County; amending chapter 2002-346, Laws of Florida; authorizing the district to make purchases up to the limit in s. 287.017(1)(a), F.S., without formal bids; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 14 of chapter 2002-346, Laws of Florida, is amended to read:

Section 14. Director; advertisement of contracts.—All work done under the provisions of this act, both in construction and maintenance, shall be carried on under the supervision of a competent entomologist, or person qualified under the provisions of chapter 388, Florida Statutes, to be employed by the board. The board may contract and purchase property or equipment without formal bids in any amount not to exceed <u>the limit set</u> forth in section 287.017(1)(a), Florida Statutes, as it may be amended from <u>time to time \$4,000</u>. All contracts or purchases in excess of <u>this limit</u> \$4,000 shall be by competitive, sealed bids, after advertisement, pursuant to rules and regulations established by the board. In the event section 287.017(1)(a), Florida Statutes, is repealed and its provisions are not recodified elsewhere in the Florida Statutes, the limit in effect prior to the repeal shall apply to the district.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
