CHAPTER 2006-106

House Bill No. 7015

An act relating to a review under the Open Government Sunset Review Act regarding archaeological sites; amending s. 267.135, F.S., which provides a public records exemption for information identifying the location of an archaeological site held by the Division of Historical Resources of the Department of State; making editorial changes; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 267.135, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

267.135 Location of archaeological sites.—Any information identifying the location of <u>an</u> archaeological <u>site held</u> sites contained in site files or other records maintained by the Division of Historical Resources of the Department of State is exempt from the provisions of s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a) of Art. I of the State Constitution, if the Division of Historical Resources finds that disclosure of such information will create a substantial risk of harm, theft, or destruction at such <u>site</u> sites. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and expires on October 2, 2006, unless reviewed and reenacted by the Legislature.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
