

House Bill No. 1145

An act relating to official state designations; creating s. 15.0301, F.S.; designating an official state motto; creating s. 15.052, F.S.; designating the future Admiral John H. Fetterman State of Florida Maritime Museum and Research Center in Pensacola as the official state maritime museum; providing for future review and repeal of the designation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 15.0301, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

15.0301 State motto.—“In God We Trust” is hereby designated and declared the official motto of the State of Florida.

Section 2. Section 15.052, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

15.052 Official state maritime museum.—

(1) The Admiral John H. Fetterman State of Florida Maritime Museum and Research Center, to be built in the City of Pensacola, is designated as the official state maritime museum.

(2) This section is repealed July 1, 2015, unless reviewed and reenacted by the Legislature before that date.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
