

Senate Bill No. 230

An act relating to state symbols; creating s. 15.0526, F.S.; designating the Florida Cracker Horse (Marshstackie) as the official state horse; providing for future legislative review and repeal; creating s. 15.0386, F.S.; designating the Loggerhead Turtle as the official Florida state salt water reptile; providing for future legislative review and repeal; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 15.0526, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

15.0526 Official state horse.—

(1) The Florida Cracker Horse (Marshstackie) is designated as the official Florida state horse.

(2) This section is repealed July 1, 2018, unless reviewed and reenacted by the Legislature before that date.

Section 2. Section 15.0386, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

15.0386 Official state salt water reptile.—

(1) The Loggerhead Turtle is designated as the official Florida state salt water reptile.

(2) This section is repealed July 1, 2018, unless reviewed and reenacted by the Legislature before that date.

Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2008.
