CHAPTER 2011-155

Senate Bill No. 898

An act relating to the Executive Office of the Governor; repealing s. 14.31(8), F.S.; abrogating the repeal of provisions governing the Florida Faith-based and Community-based Advisory Council; amending s. 14.23, F.S.; requiring the Office of State-Federal Relations to submit an annual report to the Governor and Legislature detailing its budget, personnel, and activities; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Subsection (8) of section 14.31, Florida Statutes, is repealed.
- Section 2. Present subsection (4) of section 14.23, Florida Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (5), and a new subsection (4) is added to that section, to read:
 - 14.23 State-Federal relations.—
- (4) ANNUAL REPORT.—By January 1 of each year, the office shall submit a report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives detailing the office's budget, personnel, and activities.
 - Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
