Senate Bill No. 312

An act relating to telehealth; amending s. 456.47, F.S.; revising the prohibition on prescribing controlled substances through the use of telehealth to include only specified controlled substances; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section 456.47, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

456.47 Use of telehealth to provide services.—

- (2) PRACTICE STANDARDS.—
- (c) A telehealth provider may not use telehealth to prescribe a controlled substance <u>listed in Schedule II of s. 893.03</u> unless the controlled substance is prescribed for the following:
 - 1. The treatment of a psychiatric disorder;
 - 2. Inpatient treatment at a hospital licensed under chapter 395;
- 3. The treatment of a patient receiving hospice services as defined in s. 400.601; or
- 4. The treatment of a resident of a nursing home facility as defined in s. 400.021.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022.
