CHAPTER 2014-153

House Bill No. 7145

An act relating to ratification of rules of the Department of Health; ratifying specified rules requiring certain trauma centers to maintain participation in a specified trauma quality improvement program, for the sole and exclusive purpose of satisfying any condition on effectiveness pursuant to s. 120.541(3), F.S., which requires ratification of any rule meeting any of specified thresholds for likely adverse impact or increase in regulatory costs; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. (1) The following rule is ratified for the sole and exclusive purpose of satisfying any condition on effectiveness imposed under s. 120.541(3), Florida Statutes: Rule 64J-2.006, Florida Administrative Code, titled "Trauma Registry and Trauma Quality Improvement Program," as filed for adoption with the Department of State pursuant to the certification package dated July 12, 2013.
- (2) This act serves no other purpose and shall not be codified in the Florida Statutes. After this act becomes law, its enactment and effective dates shall be noted in the Florida Administrative Code or the Florida Administrative Register or both, as appropriate. This act does not alter rulemaking authority delegated by prior law, does not constitute legislative preemption of or exception to any provision of law governing adoption or enforcement of the rules cited, and is intended to preserve the status of any cited rule as a rule under chapter 120, Florida Statutes. This act does not cure any rulemaking defect or preempt any challenge based on a lack of authority or a violation of the legal requirements governing the adoption of any rule cited.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014.
